Dad? Hey! I didn't see you parked over there. I hope I didn't keep you waiting.

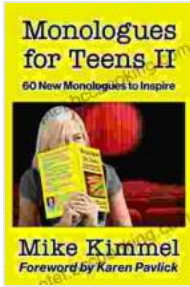
